Responsible Visitors



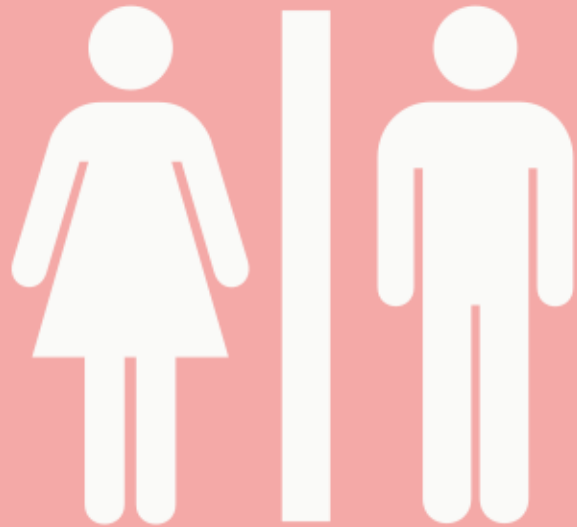
Please pick up all dog waste and dispose of responsibly. Always keep your dog in sight and under control, especially in farmed areas where livestock is nearby.
